- 1 **Fairey Battle K9328** of 218 Squadron (Boscombe Down)
Struck pylon and crashed Friday 11th August 1939
- 2 **Fairey Battle K9454** of 207 Squadron (Cranfield)
Forced landed after engine failure Tuesday 9th April 1940
- 3 **Bristol Blenheim R3597** of 218 Squadron (Mildenhall)
Struck tree and crashed Saturday 13th July 1940
- 4 **Airspeed Oxford N4729** of 14 FTS (Cranfield)
Struck tree and crashed Monday 7th October 1940
- 5 **Bristol Blenheim N3585** of 51 OTU (Cranfield)
Crashed Monday 31st August 1942
- 6 **de Havilland Mosquito DZ459** of 1655 MTU (Marham)
Struck high tension cables and crashed Sunday 18th July 1943
- 7 **Boeing B-17 Flying Fortress 42-31898** of 92nd BG (Podington)
Crashed Saturday 15th July 1944
- 8 **de Havilland Tiger Moth BB699** of 6 EFTS (Denton)
Struck power cables and crashed Tuesday 25th July 1944
